Cllr Vassie joined the meeting.

Cllr Vassie informed the meeting that resurfacing of the B1228 is to take place. He is awaiting further details on the schedule.

Cllr Vassie has now received a copy of the document on the measures to increase the energy efficiency at Elvington Primary School. It is expected that these will cost £350k.

CYC Environment Dept has met with Natural England. Help will be received in flailing the verges and increasing the diversity of the wildlife.

CYC should be doing extra road sweeping, using stronger brushes, in the village as glysophating is not taking place. Cllr Vassie will chase this. **CV**

Flooding is occurring near the Doctors' Surgery. CYC will be asked to clear out the manholes between Rebecca's Kitchen and the School.

Cllr Vassie is pursuing the provision of a night bus with colleagues at ERYC. It is suggested that a bus to Pocklington via Sutton upon Derwent and Melbourne would be welcomed by residents.
